



**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF CABINET COMMITTEE ON INFRASTRUCTURE (CCI)  
HELD ON 19<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER, 2019  
IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER**

A meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Infrastructure (CCI) was held in the Conference Hall of the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 to discuss various issues as per agenda circulated vide No. PD(SPD)-21/CCI/2019-20/2214 dated 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2019.

The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble Chief Minister and attended by Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Chief Secretary, Commissioner (FPI), Secretary to CM, Secretary (Planning) and officials of concerned Department

Concerned departments gave power point presentations on the respective proposals/issues for appraisal /consideration of the Committee. The proposals/issues were discussed in detail and after threadbare discussion, the following decisions were taken:-

**I. Decisions on Policy related issues:-**

**Decision No-1:**

It was pointed out that performance of the State under CSS schemes is not up to the mark due to non-submission of Utilisation Certificates on time to the concerned Ministry. The matter was viewed seriously by the CCI and it was decided that all efforts should be made to ensure that Utilisation Certificates are submitted to the Government of India on time and there is no delay at any level. The Committee directed the Planning & Investment Division to issue necessary notification in this regard immediately

**Decision No-2:**

The issue of delay in floating tenders against sanctioned various projects/schemes under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes was also raised in the meeting. It was proposed by the implementing departments that once a project/scheme is sanctioned by the Govt. of India, the department may be allowed to float necessary tender without waiting for concurrence from Finance Department. The Committee, in principle, agreed to the proposal and it was decided that necessary instructions may be issued to this effect by the competent authority.

**Decision No-3:**

The need for timely release of fund/LOC was discussed in the meeting. It was decided that Planning Department shall issue allocations for all schemes by 1st April every year. As far as carry forward funds are concerned, Planning department shall give part allocation in the month of April every year pending AG reconciliation based upon department's expenditure statement. Once a project/scheme is sanctioned by the competent authority and necessary documents are submitted by the concerned department, Finance Department shall issue LOC/ authorisation regularly every month from the beginning of the financial year as are done in cases of "Revenue expenditure" by the departments.
