
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

In order to provide necessary training to the unemployed youths of the State for imparting skills for taking up self employment activities as well as for enhancing their employability for other jobs, the State Government has decided that minimum 10% of fund allocated under MLA Local Area Development Scheme (MLALADS) should be utilised for capacity building and training of unemployed youths in the State.

The schemes under training and capacity building should be implemented subject to the following terms and conditions:-


1. Central / State Govt. Departments or Organisations registered with the State / Central Government or recognised by the State / Central Government will be eligible for providing training under the scheme.
2. MLAs can recommend such programmes to the concerned Deputy Commissioner who in turn, will get the proposal approved by the Skill Development Council of the State Government before implementation.
3. Trainees for such programmes will be selected by a Board under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner constituted by him for the purpose.
4. Training of educated youth for preparation of competitive exams like UPSC, Bank PO, and Staff Selection Commission, NDA or other specific recruitment tests may also be conducted subject to the condition that the trainees are not sponsored by any other programme/scheme for the purpose.
5. There should not be any duplication of funding for such training programmes and the concerned department/organisation will have to submit an undertaking in this regard to the Deputy Commissioner.
6. There should be wide publicity of such programmes through all possible means in order to ensure that the benefit of such programmes reaches to the most deserving candidates.
7. While selecting the trainees, preference should be given to the candidates belonging to the economically weaker sections of the society.
8. On successful completion of the training programme, concerned department/organisation will submit Utilisation Certificate of fund utilised under the scheme to the Deputy Commissioner.
