## BRIEF ON IMPLEMENTATION OF MPLADS IN ARUNACHAL PRADESH

There are two Lok Sabha and one Rajya Sabha Parliamentary Constituencies in Arunachal Pradesh. Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADs) is in operation in Arunachal Pradesh from 1994-95 with an allocation of Rs. 1.00crore each per annum to 2 (two) Lok Sabha Parliamentary Constituencies. During the year 1996-97 Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme was extended to the Rajya Sabha Parliamentary Constituency with an allocation of Rs. 1.00 crore per annum. From the year 1998-99, the allocation under MPLADS was increased to Rs. 2.00 crore per Parliamentary Constituency and now it is Rs 5.00 crore from the financial year 2011-12.. The objective is to enable the Members of Parliament to suggest and get executed developmental works of Capital nature based on locally felt need with emphasis on creation of durable assets.

- 2. Planning Department is the nodal department for effective implementation of the scheme and coordination with the Ministry at the Centre. In the district level, the Deputy Commissioners, West Siang District, Aalo and Lohit District, Tezu are the nodal Deputy Commissioners for implementation of the scheme in respect of Arunachal West and Arunachal East (Lok Sabha) Parliamentary Constituencies respectively. For the Rajya Sabha MPLADS, Deputy Commissioner, Papumpare District, Yupia was the nodal Deputy Commissioner, now the Deputy Commissioner Roing, Lower Dibang Valley is the nodal Deputy Commissioner.
- 3. The funds under the MPLADS are directly received by the nodal Deputy Commissioners, who in turn place fund to the concerned Deputy Commissioners on the recommendation of Member of Parliament who is responsible for getting the work sanctioned and implemented within the stipulated time in accordance with the provisions of the guidelines. MPLADS I
- The Guidelines for implementation of MPLADS were issued in February 1994 in covering the concept, implementation and monitoring of the scheme. The MPLADSs was controlled by the Ministry of Rural Development but the same was transferred to MOSPI in October, 1994. The Guidelines was subsequently revised in December, 1994, February, 1997, September 1999, April, 2001, November 2005, August 2012, May, 2014 and lastly, June, 2016
