At the outset, Secretary (Planning) welcomed the members for attending the meeting and asked for their valuable suggestions and comments during the course of meeting. Secretary (Planning) also appraised all the members to maintain the instruction issued by Ministry of Home Affairs and State Government while approving the Annual Action Plan of BADP for the current year i.e. 2016-17. Necessary formats & certificates as mentioned at para-2.1 in the revised guidelines (June'2015) should mandatorily be submitted for recommendations of the project to the MHA. A separate certificate regarding consultation of concerned MP, MLA and PRI members while preparation of AAP at the District Level are also to be submitted for further consideration.

Detailed discussions on the agenda items were held and the following decisions emerged in the meeting

Agenda Item No.1 APPROVAL FOR THE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR THE YEAR 2016-17.

The MHA had allocated an amount of 103.00 Cr under BADP during 2016-17, out of the overall allocation 5% (i.e. 5.15 Cr.) & 2.5% (i.e. 2.575 Cr.) has been kept for Capacity Building Skill Development & Training and under the discretion fund of the Chief Secretary cum Chairman SLSC. An amount of 13.72 Cr was also kept for taking up of Security Related Proposals proposed from BGFs, and an amount of 50.00 takh has been kept to meet up the expenses in connection with Third Party Monitoring etc.

- 1.1 The available fund was distributed amongst the border blocks and an amount of 1.90 Cr has been allocated to each of the 41 approved border blocks and 90.00 lake each has been allocated to the Changlang, Khonsa & Dadam blocks. The allocation for Niusa block is 45.20 lake
- Out of the total amount kept for Skill Development & Capacity Building, an amount of `12.00 lakh has been allocated to each of the 41 border blocks. The allocation for Changlang, Khonsa, Dadam & Niusa was 5.00 lakh, `7.00 lakh, `7.00 lakh & '4.00 lakh respectively.
- 1.3 Accordingly, necessary proposals have been received from the respective DCs and BGFs, compiled and placed below as Annexure I & II for consideration.

Decision:

The schemes proposed by the concerned Deputy Commissioners (DC's) were discussed and after threadbare discussion, the Chairman suggested for selection of more proposals for creating durable assets i.e residential accommodation for crucial functionaries in the border areas. The State Level Screening Committee (SLSC) has considered all the proposals and recommended for onward submission to the MHA for their consideration with some modification against specific schemes. On receipt of the rectified proposals the same was forwarded to the MHA. The Committee also decided to increase the allocation of the BGFs from the subsequent years to facilitate strict vigil of the International Border. The detailed list of schemes recommended by the SLSC is appended at Annexure-IV(a), (b), (c) & (d) respectively.

5.1 According to the BADP guidelines, the 1<sup>st</sup> installment of 90% of the allocation of the State will be released to the State only after the receipt of UCs for the amount released in the previous years except the preceding year. If there is any short fall in furnishing the UCs for the amount released during the pervious year, except the preceding year, the same would be deducted at the time of release of the 1<sup>st</sup> installment. The 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of the remaining 10% of the allocation will be released to the State only after furnishing of UCs to the extent of not less than 50% of the amount during the preceding year.
